

Home Inspection Walk-In Examination Exam Procedures (January - March 2018)

You can register for the exam at the test center, on the day of the exam. Refer to the schedule below to find the most convenient location, date and time for you to take an upcoming exam. Seats are limited and assigned on a first-come/first-served basis. If you are late, you will not be admitted into the exam.

1. What To Bring: A form of government issued signature identification which must be photo-bearing. Your identification MUST BE CURRENT (not expired) and from the following list:

- driver's license
- military ID
- United States INS issued ID
- Foreign Passport
- Brazilian, Mexican or Ecuadorian Consular ID
- state issued identification (ex. non-driver ID)
- United States Passport
- Certificate of US citizenship
- IDNYC (NYC Resident ID card)

2. \$50 examination fee: You may pay by check or money order made payable to the Department of State or charge the fee to MasterCard or Visa. Cash will not be accepted. Examination fees are nonrefundable. A \$20 fee will be charged for any returned check.

3. Admission notice (if applicable): Test Center Policies, Calculators are permitted if they are battery or solar powered, silent, nonprinting and do not contain an alphabetic keyboard. PDA's are not allowed. Cellular phones, beepers and any other electronic devices MUST be turned off during the exam. Dictionaries, books, other reference materials, large bags and briefcases are not allowed at the test center. Do not bring these materials to the test center as there is no place to store them. Eating, drinking or smoking is not permitted at the test center. If you bring food or beverages, you will be asked to dispose of them before entering the test center. Visitors, guests and children are not permitted at the test center. Any person found using notes, books, or other aids; giving or receiving help; removing examination materials or notes from the test center; causing a disturbance or engaging in practices contrary to the rules of proper examination conduct will be dismissed from the test center. Any decisions regarding disciplinary measures will be made by the Exam Supervisor at the Department of State.

Score Reporting: All exam results are reported as either passed or failed; you will not get a numerical score. You will be notified by mail as soon as your exam results are available. If you pass the written exam, you will receive a notice in the mail. That original notice (not a copy) must be submitted with your application form, license fee, etc. (Complete application details are provided in the application form instructions.) If you fail the written exam, you will receive a notice in the mail. You may use this notice to retake the exam on another date and time of your choice. Examination results are only valid for a period of two years.

Home Inspection Walk-In Examination - About the Exam January 8th, 2018 February 5th, 2018 March 5th, 2018

The exam is multiple choice, based on the 140-hour pre licensing curriculum. Applicants will be allowed 2½ hours to complete the test. The allotted time begins at the conclusion of the instructions. Exam topics include: License law; report writing; heating, cooling and plumbing systems; insulation and ventilation; structural, exterior and interior components and electrical systems.
